- Undecided : Tara and Naomi will help each other out with responsibilities for now

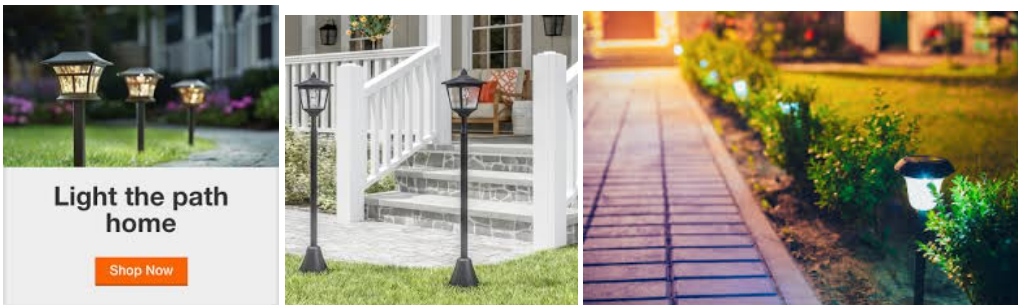
2. Updates on initiatives:
